New for fall 2024, we were excited to partner with the Village of Antioch to add a brand new location, along with utilizing the fields at the College of Lake County for our Academy Training Program. This puts our footprint in the Grayslake, Gurnee & Antioch communities as a feeder system into our organization.

A total of 190 of players participated across our fall, winter and spring seasons, which made this season our largest attendance to date.

Finally, we welcome 22 graduates of our Academy program who are joining our U8 teams to begin their travel soccer journey's in the 2024-25 season.

# Development of an FCLC Game Model

Through the work on the Director of Coaching license, it has given me a greater understanding on how to pair my ideas for player and team development in connection with creating a specific style of play into a usable template. Much of the groundwork began over the winter season with all coaches utilizing age group training sessions across all teams. During the spring season, we introduced core activities that are taught on a consistent basis at the beginning of each training session to better develop each player's physical speed and mobility, in addition to key technical competencies of dribbling, passing and ball striking. Further concepts will be implemented into our new curriculums to make each session relevant to the age and ability level of the players involved.
